Orientation Program for ATC Students

1. Introduction

The Automotive Training Centre (ATC) Surrey welcomes international students from around the world. - Academic Success: Outlines attendance policies, grading systems, classroom expectations, and available tutoring or ESL support.
- Community and Cultural Integration: Helps students understand Canadian customs, communication styles, and multicultural engagement opportunities.

4. Orientation Delivery Methods

- In-Person Sessions: Conducted at the ATC Surrey campus prior to the start of classes, with opportunities to meet staff and peers.
- Online Resources: Accessible through the ATC website for pre-arrival preparation, including downloadable handbooks and checklists.
- Recorded Sessions: Available for students who are unable to attend live sessions due to travel or time differences.
- Email and Virtual Support: Continuous communication with the Student Services team for follow-up and individual guidance.

5. Orientation Checklist for International Students

Before Arrival:

- Review your Letter of Acceptance and study permit details.
- Arrange temporary or permanent housing near ATC Surrey.
- Purchase health insurance coverage.
- Prepare travel documents and contact information.
- Attend online pre-arrival information session (if available).

Upon Arrival:

- Attend the in-person orientation session.
- Obtain your student ID and login credentials.
- Review course schedules and class locations.
- Learn about emergency contacts and safety procedures.
- Connect with Student Services for support and resources.

7. Support Services for International Students

ATC Surrey's Student Services team provides ongoing assistance to ensure international students have a smooth transition. Support includes housing guidance, academic advising, career development, and cultural adjustment resources.
